World Powerboat Championship in class O – 250

The International Championship of Poland In classes O-700, S-550, JT-250, T-400, T-550, O-125.

The Rules of the Championship

1. ORGANIZERS

The Powerboat Races Organization Committee in Janikowo, authorized by the Polish Powerboat and Water Ski Federation in Warsaw supported by the authorities of the Town Hall in Janikowo and the Speaker's Office of the Kujawsko-Pomorskie region, Regional Authority in Inowroclaw.

2. DATE AND PLACE OF THE RACES

The races will be held in Janikowo, Poland, on Pakoskie lake from 9th to 10th of June, 2007, according to the UIM and MMP schedule.

3. RULES AND BOAT CLASSES

3.1. The competition will be held according to the UIM and MMP regulations, as well as these Championship Regulations.

3.2. World Championship will be held in class O – 250.

3.3. The International Competition – Polish Powerboat Championship qualifying round will be held in the O-700 ,O-125, S-550, T-400, T-550 , JT-250 class.

4. RACES

- 4.1. The race course will be a closed circle marked with the turn buoys as show in the sketch included.
- 4.2. The length of the course is 1 500 m.
- 4.3. 18 boats are allowed to start in any class.
- 4.4. If more competitors apply, additional qualifying heat with 5 laps each will take place, according to art. 304.03 of UIM Regulations.
- 4.5. Four heats, eight laps each will take place in Europe Championship O 250.

- The best three results will count to the final score.
- 4.6. Three races eight laps each will take place in other classes and all the results will be counted to the final score.
- 4.7. The length of the course in JT-250 class is 6.000 m. (4 laps)
- 4.8. An additional safety lap is obligatory in every class.
- 4.9. The boat which will not follow its lap or will remain silent for the course closing signals will be disqualified.
- 4.10. Any interrupted heat will be repeated only once art. 311,02 of UIM.
- 4.11. The competitor will be classified if he manages over 70 % of the winner's course and will pass the finishing line after the winning boat has been waved with a flag

5. START

- 5.1. Start from the floating stage. Start procedure with a light according to the UIM art. 307 remains valid.
- 5.2. All information connected with the start will be presented with boards from the Starter's stand.
- 5.3. Only the involved competitors and two of their mechanics are allowed to stay at the start pier during the start.
- 5.4. The positions at the start pier to the first heat will be determined according to the time of trial results.
- 5.5. The competitor late at the start can leave the jetty only to the buoy number 3 until the red light is on

6. BOAT PARK (DEPO)

- 6.1. Boat Park will be guarded from 12:00 a.m. June, the 8th to 6:00 p.m. June, the 10th, 2007.
- 6.2. Only authorized people with ID plates are allowed to enter the Boat Park.
- 6.3. Children under the age of 10 are absolutely forbidden to enter the Boat Park.
- 6.4. Staying at the Boat Park at night, i.e. between 10.00 p.m. and 6.00 a.m. next day is forbidden.
- 6.5. In case the siren is sounded, the Boat Park has to be left immediately.
- 6.6. Smoking and using open fire in the Boat Park is strictly forbidden.

- 6.7. There is an obligation to place a fire extinguisher next to every boat in the Boat Park.
- 6.8. Competitors in any class are to stay on the sites for each class either provided for them or indicated by the Boat Park staff.
- 6.9. Vehicle parking as well as sleeping in the Boat Park are forbidden.

7. BOAT LAUNCHING

- 7.1. The boats of S-550, T-400, T-550 and O-700 classes will be launched and lifted with a crane. The crane can be used only for the boats which have their own attested hooks and slings.
- 7.2. The crane can be used only in the presence of the competitor or the mechanic and at their responsibility.
- 7.3. Nobody is allowed to stay on board or within the reach of the crane.

8. COMPETITORS MEETING

8.1. Obligatory Competitors Meeting in the presence of the UIM Representative will take place on June the 9th and 10th, 2007 inside the Boat Park according to the time schedule. Competitor's absence or late coming during the competitors' list reading at the meeting will be punished with a fine of 300 PLN.

9. TECHNICAL INSPECTION

- 9.1. Technical Inspection will take place in the Boat Park on June the 8th from 12: 00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. as well as on 9th of June from 08:00 a.m. to 10:00.
- 9.2. During the technical inspection the conformity of all the elements of the equipment with the regulations of UIM will be required. The Technical Board can weigh the boat and measure the noise level of the engine.

10. TRAININGS

- 10.1. Training is allowed only on the race course, after the technical inspection and according to the timetable.
- 10.2. During the training on 9th of June, 2007 the time of 2 laps of each competitor will be measured. (It will be the criterion to take the start position during the first race)

- 10.3. Excluding the master's class in case of elimination races.
- 10.4. Arbitrary launching beyond the schedule will lead to disqualification.

11. PARTICIPATION

- 11.1 Taking part in the competition is allowed on condition that the participant has valid license, certificate, valid medical examination, required insurance policy OC (civil liability) bought at the organizers, required homologations, diving test (concerns class O-700).
- 11.2 The minimum age of competitor is 16.
- 11.3 In JT-250 class the minimum age of the competitor is 10, according to the regulations of M.M.P. for Polish competitors 12 years.
- 11.4 In T-400 class minimum age of the competitor is 14.

12. APPLICATIONS

12.1 The applications on the sheets enclosed or on their copies are to be sent till 20th of May, 2007 by post, fax or e-mail to:

The application signed in person will be understood as the acceptance of the 'Janikowo 2007' regulations.

13. INSURANCE

- 13.1 The competitor is allowed to start in the competition only when he has valid policies, following the requirements of the hereby regulations, that is point 13.2 and 13.3
- 13.2. Every competitor is obliged to buy at the competitions' office a civil liability insurance policy which will cost 100,00 PLN, excluding the

- equipment damages.
- 13.3. The organizers require the accident insurance policy and medical treatment policy in Poland NW-either issued in Poland or translated into Polish or English and certified by the insurer.
- 13.4. The organizer will enable the competitors to buy any kind of insurance- the accident insurance policy NW and medical treatment in Poland. Insurer will not insure the boats of competitors participating in the race.

14. ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION

- 14.1. Every competitor is obliged to protect the environment.
- 14.2. An absorbing carpet is to be placed under every engine.
- 14.3. All kinds of waste and used oil are to be discarded in special containers in the Boat Park.
- 14.4. The boats can be refueled only in the zone provided by the organizers.
- 14.5. Noise level during the training and race will be measured according to the UIM regulations art. 504.03.

15. FUEL

- 15.1 The competitors of **S**, **T**, **JT** classes are allowed to start only on the fuel bought from the Petrol Station in Janikowo, at Przemyslowa street.
- 15.2 Every competitor of **S**, **T**, **JT** classes must buy the proper amount of fuel and provide the Technical Judges Board with the receipt or invoice.
- 15.3 The organizers provide the unleaded petrol with the octane rating 98 RON produced by PKN ORLEN S.A. in Nowa Wieś Wielka for 1 euro per liter according to art. 508.02 of UIM regulations.
- 15.4 The technical specification of the fuel will be provided in the Petrol Station.

16. CLASSIFICATION

16.1 The competitors will be classified according to the UIM regulations art. 318.01.

17. PROTESTS

- 17.1 Protests will be accepted only in a form from art. 408 of UIM regulations, according to the UIM procedure art. 402 and 403 at the Race Office.
- 17.2 The deposit for the protest is 300,00 PLN.

18. INTERNATIONAL JURY

18.1 The member of the International Jury will be a person delegated by the national federation, provided that he/she presents the written authorization before 8the of June, 2007 till 06:00 p.m. at the Race Office.

19. PRIZES AND GIFTS

- 19.1 In O 250 class the competitors receive the UIM medals for the 1st ,2nd and 3rd place and cups from organizers for places from 1st to 6th .
- 19.2 In other classes the winners will get valuable cups for the 1st ,2nd and 3rd place.

20. FOOD AND ACCOMMODATION

- 20.1 The reservation of accommodation and meals will be made only on the basis of the previous application.
- 20.2 All competitors take part in the competition at their own cost.
- 20.3 Full board will cost 40,00 PLN only following earlier reservation.
- 20.4 Accommodation is available at costs ranging from 30,00 to 150,00 PLN per day (student's houses and hotels).
- 20.5 The camp in the distance of 10 meters from the Boat Park provided with the basic sanitary appliances is free.

21. RECEPTION

The Race Reception Office will be placed in designated and signed part of the "Kormoran" Sailing Club, Janikowo, Główna street 39.

The working hours are:

8th of June, 2007 at 12:00 a.m. -08:00 p.m.

9th of June, 2007 at 07:00 a.m. -11:00 a.m.

10th of June, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. - 04:00 p.m.

22. FINAL REGULATIONS

- 22.1 The Organizers reserve the right to change the regulations for any reason beyond their control.
- 22.2 The competitors will be informed about all the changes with a special

notice in writing, which will also be read during the competitors' meeting.

- 22.3 The Medical Commissioner or appointed doctor reserves the right to carry out medical examination of any of the competitors in time appointed by the Organizers. The competitors' health records will be held by the organizer for the time of the competition.
- 22.4 Every competitor is obliged to take part in the opening celebrations of the Races and solemn march (presentation of the competitors on the podium concerns the competitors of O 250).
- 22.5 The Organizers are entitled to interpret any of the above regulations.
- 22.6 The circuit may be changed following the reasons irrespective of the Organizers, every participant will receive a special notice and a new map with the race route marked.
- 22.7 The damaged buoy will be charged 1500,00 PLN, art. 313,03 of UIM regulations.
- 22.8 The Judges Board **can** check the level of alcohol in blood according to the art.205.02, as well as control the fuel, art. 508.09 of UIM regulations.
- 22.9 The competitor of class O-250 who will be willing to place a sponsor's advertisement on his/her boat for the time of competition will not have to cover the costs of obligatory insurance. It will be covered by the sponsor.
